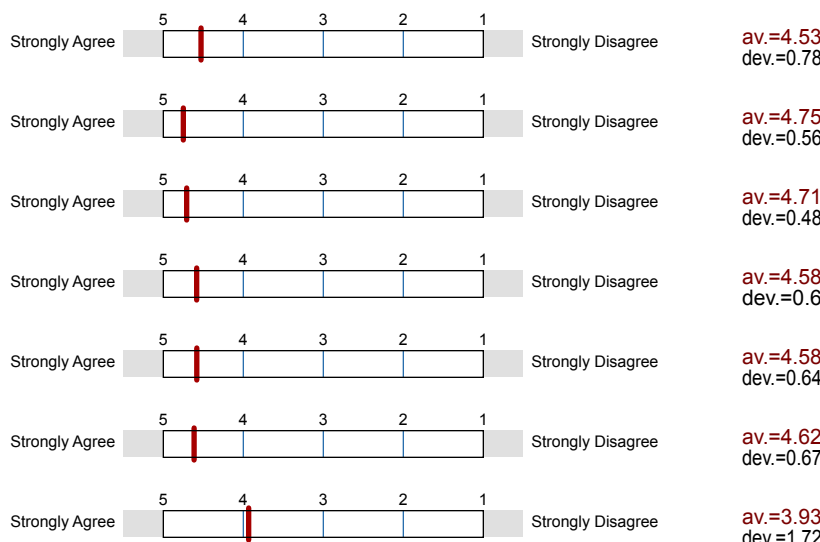

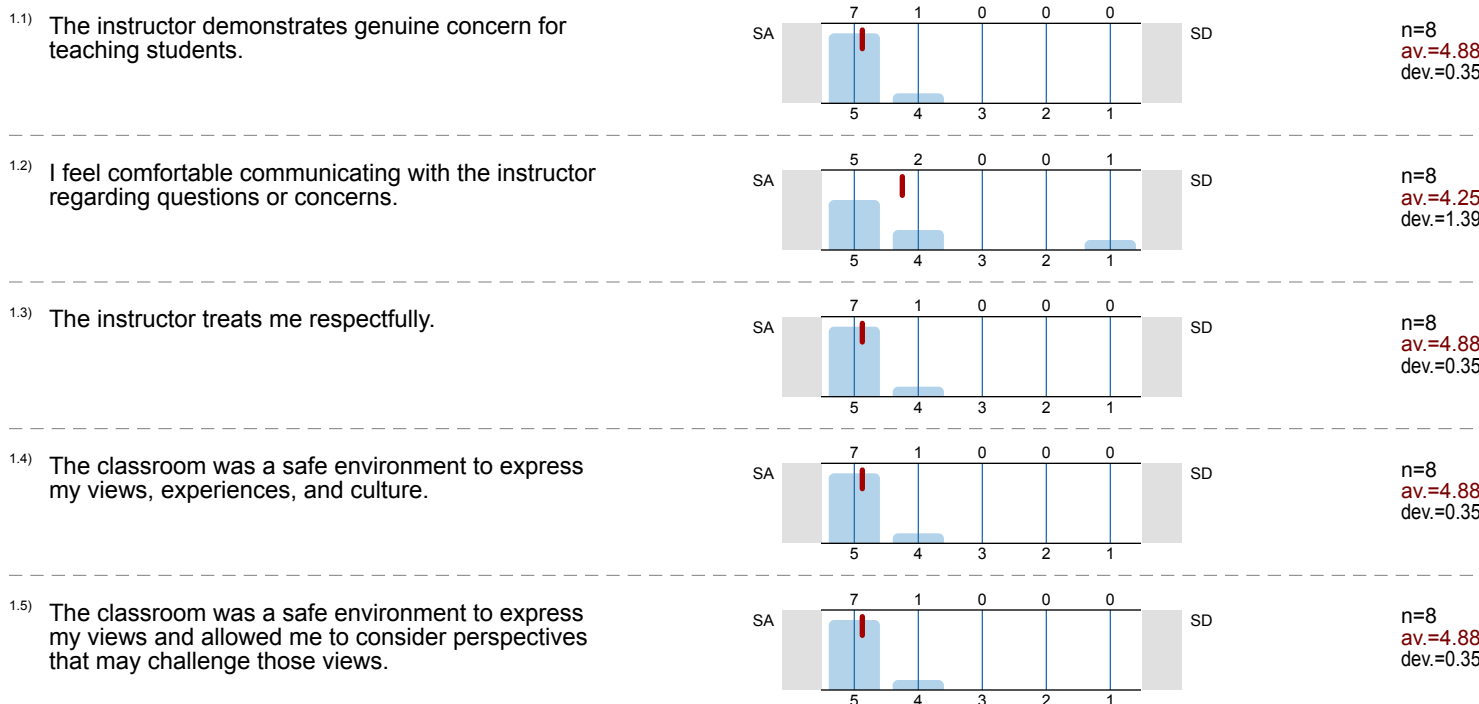

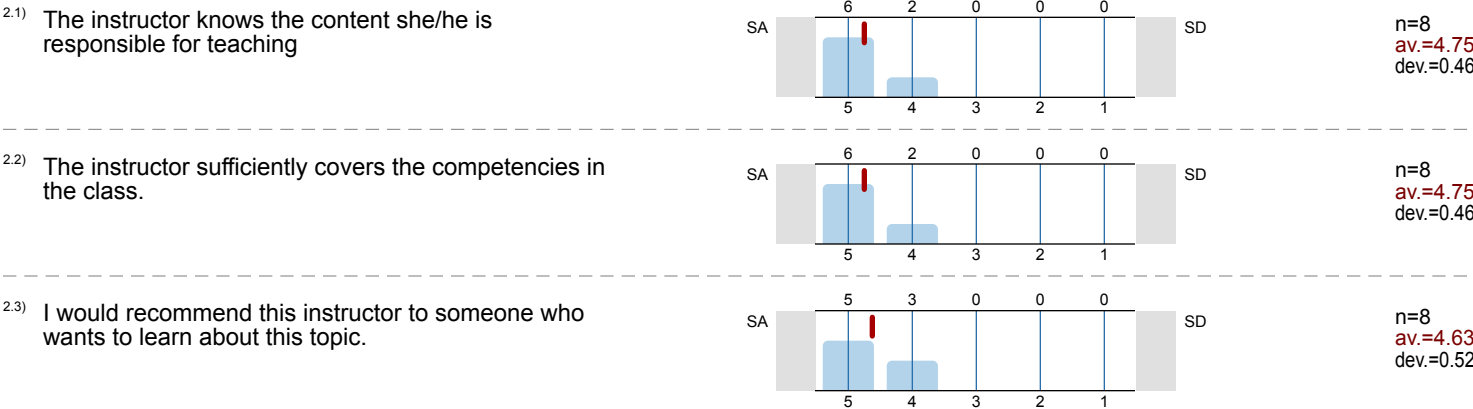

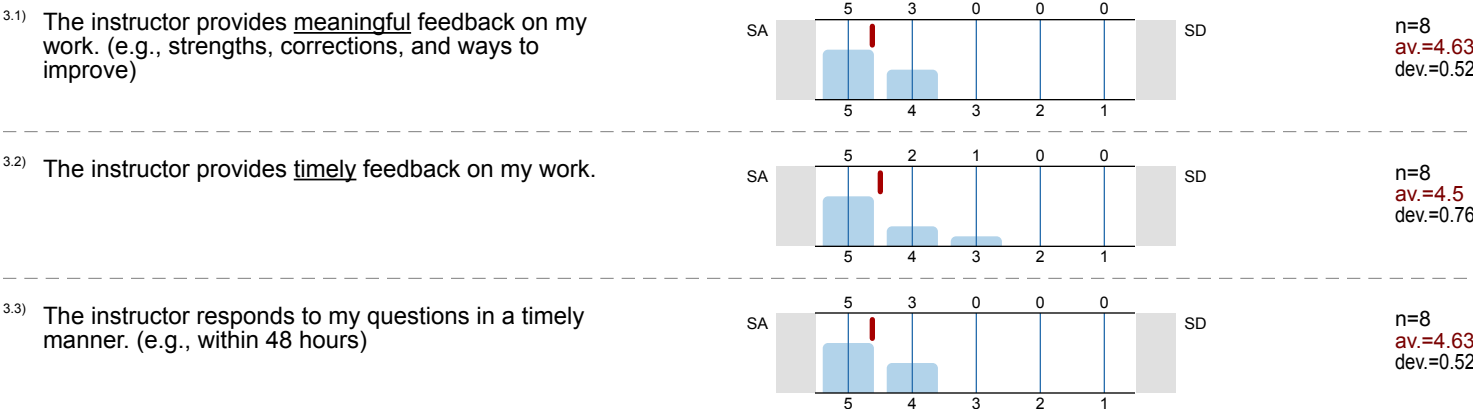

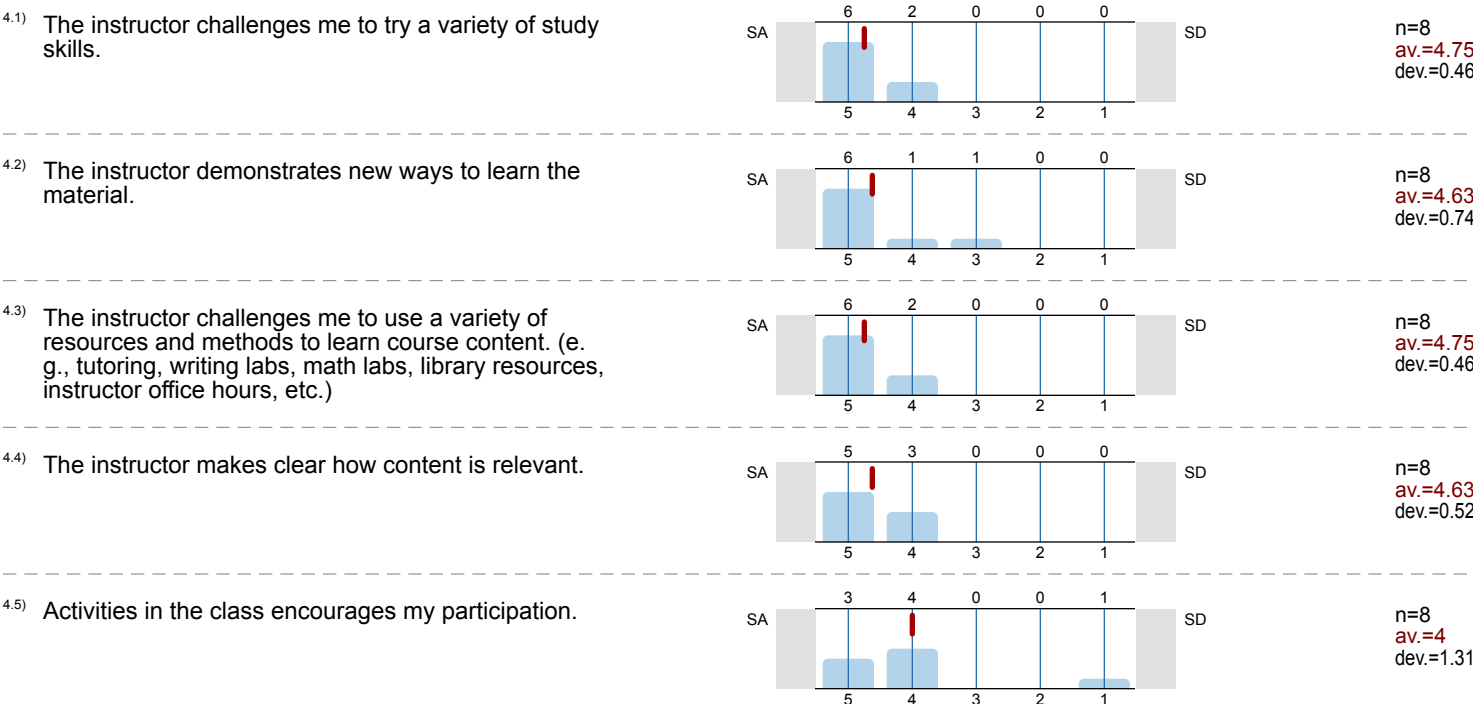

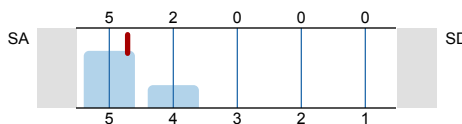
3. Quality and Timeliness of Instructors Feedback

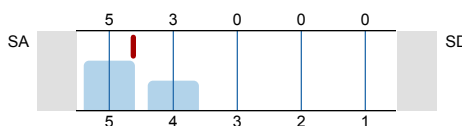

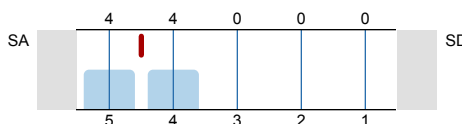

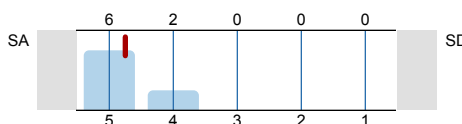

5.1) The instructor presents material in an organized manner.



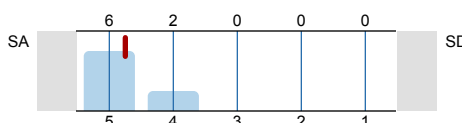

5.2) The instructor makes it clear what work is expected of me and when each assignment is due.



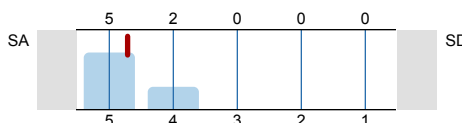

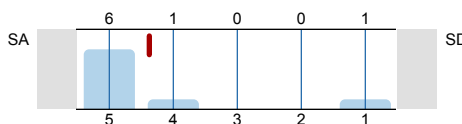

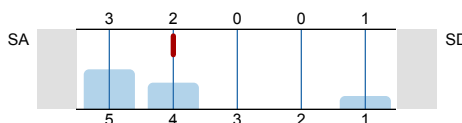

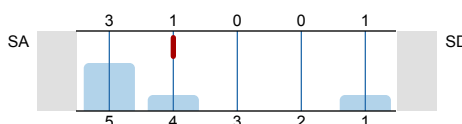

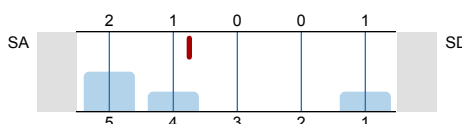

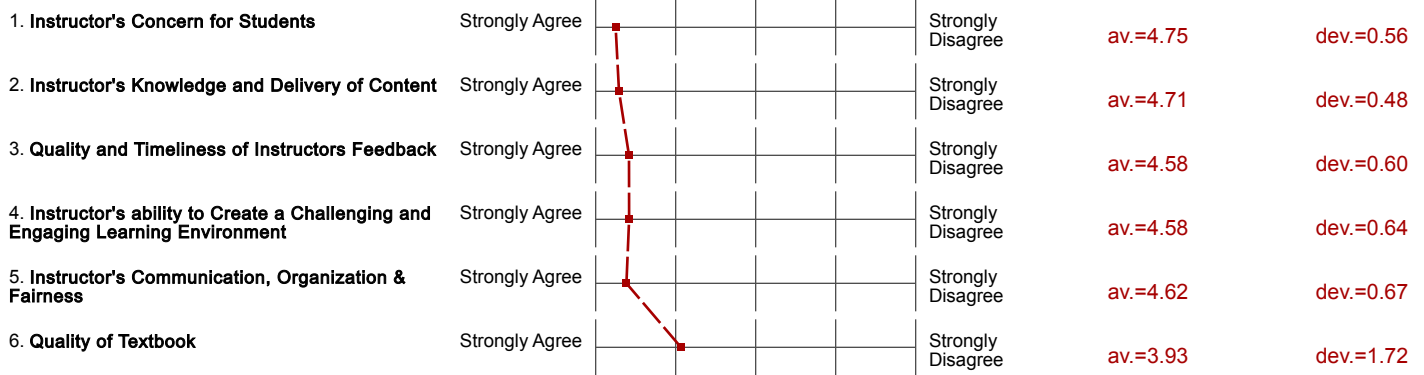
